I've finally reached the point where I've had enough energy to participate in some online activities. I've been particularly encouraged by a Creative Christian summit in the UK with some excellent teaching on Colossians and some really enjoyable creative sessions (including lettering). I also took part in an Orality workshop looking at how to communicate with people from Oral cultures. Although it was an international event, the other participants in my group had links to Latin America or Prison ministries so it was great to share ideas.

For the last couple of weeks 18 – 65yr olds have been allowed out for an hour's exercise near their house. Pat & I met for a hot chocolate & a walk in a park which was lovely. In July, adults in Lima will be allowed out during the day without the need for a special travel permit. There will still be a curfew each night but we'll be allowed out on Sundays for the first time. Children under 14 will be allowed out for an hour each day. I am hoping to be able to meet up with some more friends at a safe distance!
